



Important Washing Instructions for Ultra-15[®] Microfiber Towels & Apparel

The Doctor says: “You bought these towels with the money you earned, if you wash ‘em wrong they can’t be returned!”

Thank you for purchasing this new exclusive salon towel for the beauty industry. Safe-2-Bleach[®] Towels are the ONLY microfiber towels that are safe to use with bleach! They are not affected by peroxide-based hair products. Safe-2-Bleach[®] Towels can safely be washed with hot water and chlorine bleach without fading or damaging the towel. This larger heavier weight microfiber towel is specifically designed to dry hair quickly. Safe-2-Bleach[®] Towels absorb water 4x faster than traditional cotton towels. Just wash & dry one or two towels and test them. **REMEMBER, THERE ARE NO RETURNS ON WASHED TOWELS.**

Please wash Safe-2-Bleach[®] Microfiber Towels separately, without fabric softener, BEFORE YOU PLACE THEM INTO USE. Kindly follow washing instructions listed on the yellow product label sewn on to each towel. They can also be found on page 15 of our brochure, on our website, on the packing list that came with your order and at the bottom of this document. **Towels should be dried in low heat** and will dry 10 to 20 minutes faster than cotton towels. Enjoy what Ultra-15 microfiber towels will do for you!

WASHING MICROFIBER TOWELS & SPA APPAREL-

These are the towels you bought, you better do what you ought. **YOU MUST WASH AND DRY TOWELS PRIOR TO USE. DRY TOWELS WITH LOW HEAT ONLY.**

Washing is easily done by just placing the products into a washing machine and washing with any soap or detergent you prefer. However, there are **FOUR** restrictions: (1) Never wash Microfiber products with cotton fabrics... especially towels! **If you wash them with cotton, they will soon be forgotten.**

The Microfiber products will treat the lint generated by the cotton fabric like dirt and store the tiny cotton particles within the microfibers. (2) Never use fabric softener. The Microfiber will accumulate fabric softener as if it were “Scotch Guard” (water repellent) and saturate the microfibers, reducing their effectiveness. **(3) Use low temperature when drying.** (4) Do not use bleach with microfiber unless it is Safe-2-Bleach[®].
